



New travel regulations for UK and European Union

Global travel regulations are evolving, here's a quick breakdown to the three key upcoming systems that will affect travel to the UK and the EU:

- ✓ [UK Electronic Travel Authorisation \(ETA\)](#): Non-visa visitors to the UK will need to apply for an ETA ahead of their journey.
- ✓ [EU Entry/Exit System \(EES\)](#): All non-EU travellers to the Schengen Zone can use the digitalised border system with biometrics to enter, no more manual stamping of passports.
- ✓ [European Travel Information and Authorisation System \(ETIAS\)](#): Visa-free visitors to the EU's Schengen Area will need to apply for an ETIAS ahead of their journey.

Top Tips for Easy Travel:

- ✓ **Check requirements early**: Don't forget to apply for ETA (UK) or ETIAS (EU) before travelling!
- ✓ **Be prepared at the border**: Get used to biometric checks (fingerprints, face scans) under EES.
- ✓ **Stay informed**: Dates are rolling out – plan ahead to avoid surprises!
