

New travel regulations for UK and European Union

Global travel regulations are evolving, here's a quick breakdown to the three key upcoming systems that will affect travel to the UK and the EU:

- ✓ <u>UK Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA):</u> Non-visa visitors to the UK will need to apply for an ETA ahead of their journey.
- ✓ <u>EU Entry/Exit System (EES):</u> All non-EU travellers to the Schengen Zone can use the digitalised border system with biometrics to enter, no more manual stamping of passports.
- ✓ <u>European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS)</u>: Visa-free visitors to the EU's Schengen Area will need to apply for an ETIAS ahead of their journey.

Top Tips for Easy Travel:

- ✓ Check requirements early: Don't forget to apply for ETA (UK) or ETIAS (EU) before travelling!
- ✓ Be prepared at the border: Get used to biometric checks (fingerprints, face scans) under EES.
- ✓ Stay informed: Dates are rolling out plan ahead to avoid surprises!
